I have missed seeing all of you! The good news is that we are finally able to worship together in-person at 9am on Sundays during the summer. There will be no Wednesday night worship until further notice.

Thanks to the technical expertise of Craig Hertsgaard, along with the talents of LaVonne Nokleberg, Cheryl Rostad, Erin Kub, Kensey Knight, Becca Fiesel, Tori Braaten, and Scott and Vickie Milbrandt, we have been able to live stream worship on Facebook over the past three months! I am so grateful to God for them and their faithfulness! You can participate in worship from home by watching on Facebook.

We have installed a permanent camera and have modified the sound system so this is an on-going part of our ministry. Thank you to Craig Hertsgaard, Scott Bartram, Todd Miller, and Nick Milbrandt for making this possible! We welcome Brady Mitchell as the newest member of our live streaming team. Please contact Pastor Andrew or Craig Hertsgaard if you would like to become a member of this team.

As we resume worshiping inperson, we trust you to make the best choices for yourself. Please note the following guidelines:

- We recommend that people stay at home if they are immunocompromised or at high risk due to other health factors.
- Please refrain from attending inperson worship if you have any symptoms of being ill.

Our custodian, Mike, will continue to disinfect the public spaces weekly. During worship:

- Maintain 6 feet of distance between family groups. This means sitting every other pew.
- We have hand sanitizer stations around the church
- There will be no bulletins.
- No shaking hands during the sharing of the peace
- We will continue to collect offering at the back of the sanctuary.
- The ministry of the church continues, so please consider electronic giving through the KLC church app, texting a dollar amount to 701-401-3349, direct bill pay from your bank account, or mailing a check to the church. Thank you for your generosity.
- At the present time we will refrain from celebrating Holy Communion, but will hopefully resume in the fall.



With no further business for discussion, Motion by Suzanne Wolf to adjourn 2nd Tony Gray.




