Our solemn time in Lent leads us not to despair but to celebration of what Jesus has done for us and how Jesus continually works in our lives. There is so much to look forward to in Lent and beyond, so I invite you to come, see, and experience all that God is doing at Kindred Lutheran.

Management & Grounds:

Installed a new garage door opener, snow blower is still getting fixed, urinal leak at church was fixed, furnace at church was looked at, A/C & furnace at Parsonage need replacing-hopefully this year, Excel looked at the A/C unit in Pastors office.

Social Ministry & Outreach:

Mission Committee will be collecting some special offerings soon...

Love offering will go to a local resident with health issues.

Lenten Soup & Sandwich offerings will go towards the Great Plains Food Pantry. Lenten Worship offerings will go to Doctors Without Borders.

Old Business:
