Call to Order-Meeting called to order at 11:20am by Rich. Lloyd, Gene, Kathryn and Susie (by phone) were present. Lisa and Lori were absent.

Secretary's Report/Approval of Minutes- No meeting minutes available to review for November as were not able to access library for meeting. Will review at January's meeting.

Treasurer's Report / Approval of Report

• Financials down from last year by around \$12,000. Expenses were down as well. Planning on paying off \$19,794 that is left on LOC. Loan balloon payment due in November, for east lot, was extended for 3 years. Motion to approve Treasurer's report by Kathryn, second by Gene. Motion carried.

Updates from Directors:

Faith Formation & Growth

• Lori was absent from the meeting.

<u>Management & Grounds</u>

- Gene checking with Lock Shop for a master key for code door so that we can reset and set up new codes if needed.
- Limited money in budget for lighting. Will check into replacing just the kitchen and replacing bulbs in the fellowship hall. Checking into needs for Organist and Music Director per previous bid (Dakota Hills Electric)
- Bekki has been handling cameras-reset account, turning on and charging, etc.
- The washing machine in the parsonage needs a new seal-Gene will look into replacing.
- Door lock for garage for parsonage. Gene will also check into this.

<u>Social Ministry & Outreach</u>

- Chair bids in process. Cost is between \$6,000-\$15,000.
- Susie will check into bids to have both carpets cleaned in parsonage and church.
- Also obtaining bids for painting for both fellowship areas for church and for parsonage.

Old Business

- Call committee update-Feedback for 2nd interview of candidate was positive. Possibility of 2nd interview for another candidate as well. Call committee remains in constant communication with the Council and the Synod. Call committee continues to look for the candidate committed to KLC!
- Parsonage-updates as above in Mgmt and Grounds. Susie will check on parsonage more frequently.

New Business

- Lloyd will contact Pr. Phil to see if he could help with coverage in January. If not will have to use pulpit supply.
- Christmas Eve services-Susie is ushering so she will open/lock church. Will plan to broadcast 4pm services only on Facebook.
- Facebook coverage for worship-Scott will be scaling back to helping with the Facebook live stream only 1 time a month. Need to reach out to Trish to coordinate coverage with Confirmation students.
- Gift cards for staff- Motion to approve gift cards for staff by Lloyd. Second by Kathryn. Motion approved.
- With no current Pastor, Rich will check to see if we could have dinner as a group (council, church staff).
- December 26th Services- No Facebook stream. Pr. Bloom not available so will need to work on finding individuals to help read scripture as there will be limited council attendance. Susie can unlock church. Lloyd will lock church.
