Present: Pr. Michael Buller, Rich Schock, Lisa Hosman–Davis, Lloyd Hoffarth, Lori Pearson, Susie Mathias Absent: Kathryn Gray, Rob Sahr

Call to Order at 6:35pm by President Rich Schock.

Minutes - Not approved due to Kathryn's absence. Review prior to next meeting for approval in October.

Treasurer's Report: Motion made by Lisa H-D; 2nd by Susie Mathias; Motion Carried.

- Bookkeeping was transferred to Erickson Bookkeeping.
- \$20k from Endowment Fund to checking to pay off the Line of Credit (LOC). Remaining balance of LOC to be paid from unrestricted funds.
- Discussion to discontinue the allocations that were set up. VANCO will have to cancel these and the congregation member will have to redesignate their donation.
- Need to remind congregation that KLC is enrolled in Amazon Smile. Generated \$195.59 as of August 2021. Pays 0.05% of qualified purchases.
- Water usage on the meter was high this past month. Pr. will monitor but likely related to the roof project.
- \$1200 payment received from the Whitehead funeral. Need to pay the staff that worked the event.

Pastor's Report:

- Confirmation Orientation on September 8 for 7th and 8th graders; Two students from Shepherd of the Prairie joining the confirmation class.
- · Youth will be involved in the Committees as part of the confirmation requirement
- Rally Sunday will be Blessing of Students and Teachers
- 9th Graders will start presenting Faith Statements during service on Sept. 19; also day of Confirmand Blessing; Confirmation class begins Sept. 22. Will be following the Revised Common Lectionary so coincides with church service
- Pre-K will take a tour of the church and have snacks on October 3rd with Pr.
- Bibles will be presented on October 10. Lloyd and Bekki ordered and coordinating with Kindred Kids.
- Stephens Ministry Pr. has been visiting with those 70+ via phone and in-person

Update from Directors:

Faith Formation & Growth

- On September 1st, Trish, Pr., and Lori met to discuss the respective roles and expectations regarding confirmation. Need to look at fall calendar and set up a meeting time to prepare for the fall events.
- Confirmation Dinner is scheduled for October 30 at 630p in Fellowship Hall; Confirmation Sunday on October 31
- Kindred Kids Committee: VBS discussed the future of VBS being a community event vs. KLC event will depend on other Parish's preferred length as KLC prefers multiple evenings throughout the week and other churches are going to a one-day program. Sunday School Registration is complete; 82 children enrolled. Currently have 8 substitutes also signed up. First teacher meeting is September 8 at 7pm to introduce new curriculum
- Stewardship Committee (K. Johnson): Surveys will be sent out and mailed out to seek the known and unknown talents of the congregation
- Youth Director: Reached out to Pr. Katie at Norman/Davenport Parish to combine for attending the National Youth Gathering (tentatively scheduled for Oct); they have new vaccination guidelines for attending inperson. Selling the extra food from the Burger Stand. Castaway Camp was canceled for Fall 2021.

Management & Grounds

- Rob Sahr turned in written resignation effective September 15
- Will need to seek new Director for this position. Susie will be reaching out to Gene Thompson to see if he is interested in a temporary fill for this position until the end of this calendar year since he has past experience
- Need to get the lock on the closet door
- Need to check the lock/key on Trish's office door; window in YD office is also leaking. Rob and Pr. did look at this.




