Proposed Changes to be Voted on at the Annual Meeting

Current Mission Statement

The Triune God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, is a missional God, actively ushering in his Kingdom, proclaiming forgiveness of sin, setting captives free, healing, reconciling the world to himself and transforming his people through Jesus Christ and him crucified. Jesus invites us to follow him and be his hands and feet for the sake of the world. We do not go to church ..we are the church. We witness to the coming of the Kingdom of God through the life, suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
