Siblings in Christ,

We marked the end of our Sunday School and Confirmation years, celebrated our graduates, gave thanks for our mothers, observed Memorial Day with reverence, and wrapped it all up with the joy and energy of Vacation Bible School. That is a lot to be grateful for, and I want to thank everyone who participated, volunteered, taught, encouraged, or simply showed up. It truly takes a village, and our church family showed up in a big way.

Now, as we step into the slower rhythm of summer, I want to take a moment to reflect with you.

Your ongoing giving helps support everything from worship and pastoral care to outreach and upkeep. **Even during the quieter months, your generosity keeps us strong and ready for all God is calling us to do.**

Galatians 6:9 encourages us, "Let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up." Sometimes, doing what is right looks like making space for God in the midst of a busy or even restful life. It means showing up, staying connected, keeping the faith, and planting seeds that will bear fruit in due time.

So as you grill burgers, plan road trips, chase kids through the sprinkler, or find a quiet spot to watch the stars, know this: your church is still here, praying for you, cheering you on, and ready to welcome you each week. You are a vital part of this community, and your presence matters more than you know.




