

Pastor's Report:

Starting 7th & 8th grade Confirmation (30–35 kids) Wednesday, 9–21, & 9th graders starting Sunday, 9–25. Will split up the 10th grade families to help with the dinner for this year's 9th grade Confirmands since it's a small class. Pastor will be in Crookston October 9–11. Pastor will be gone Sunday October 23rd and we'll need pulpit supply.

Updates from Directors:

Faith Formation & Growth:

• Registration online for Sunday School was down, but had a great turnout on the first day! Trish is with 25 kids (15 from KLC & 10 from Norman Lutheran) at Camp Castaway. 4th grade Classroom wall is fixed (scrapped, primed twice with Dry-Lock, & painted by Lisa & Kathryn). Management & Grounds:

-Parsonage is 95% complete (need a couple ceiling tiles). Final repairs from Handy
Randy's will be done soon and will get a detailed invoice for insurance. Will look at snow blower and
do any maintenance this Fall. HVAC vents were cleaned. Lights in the living room and above the
counter were installed by Nick Milbrandt. Will fix shades in the sanctuary soon (waiting for parts).

Social Ministry & Outreach:

Service projects for 9-25... LeAnn Toppen will have a group inside making cards for
the ND Veterans Home in Lisbon. Other items on the list include...tree trimming/branch pick up
around the church, picking up litter around town from Homecoming, weeding Prayer Garden,
washing windows of SS rooms, an apartment nearby needs a few things done, etc. Will have a chili
feed afterwards. A suggestion was made to have new bags for kids during worship, and will look
into this.

Old Business:

- -Giving online, looking at a new system for electronic giving
- -Gift Policy-Pastor Kyle has a draft and we'll look over and discuss at the next meeting. Will have it finalized for the Annual meeting where it'll need to be voted on for approval.

New Business:

- -Budget items for the Parsonage (A/C, etc.). Will get a list made for present/future items.
- -Secretary position is filled by Leah Lundquist. Bekki will help train Mon-Wed and her final day of availability is 10–12. A "Farewell" fellowship after worship is planned for 10–16. Motion to adjourn by Gene, Seconded by Kathryn. Motion approved.
