At the heart of our faith is Jesus' commandment to love one another as He has loved us. This love is not simply a feeling or ideal; it is the very essence of who we are as His followers. And it is no coincidence that Jesus connects this call to love with His own example: love that is sacrificial, self-giving, and boundless—a love most clearly revealed in His death on the cross and His resurrection from the grave.

Through His crucifixion, Jesus bore the weight of our sin and brokenness. He showed us that true love is willing to sacrifice for the sake of others. In His resurrection, He triumphed over death, giving us new life and the power to love as He loves. This love, poured out for us, is what we are called to embody in our daily lives. It is also the love that claims us in baptism, uniting us with Christ and making us part of His mission to heal a broken world.

In today's divided and hurting world, living out this love is more important than ever. We are surrounded by voices that encourage division, fear, and hate, but as disciples of Jesus, we are called to be different. We are called to be people of love—people who choose compassion, reconciliation, and hope, even when it's difficult. And this love isn't something we muster on our own; it is the love of Christ, alive in us through His Spirit, that enables us to live boldly and generously.

This month, I invite you to reflect on how God is calling you to live out this love. One way we can do this together is through our **Love Offering** on **Sunday, February 9**, which will support Joan Pratt, a member of our Kindred community who has spent her life caring for children and families. As she faces the challenges of cancer, this is an opportunity for us to extend the love of Christ to her through prayer, encouragement, and generosity.

But let us also remember that love is not limited to grand gestures. Every time we come together in worship, every time we encourage one another in faith, and every time we use our God-given gifts to serve, we are participating in the love of Christ. As we walk in the shadow of the cross and the light of the empty tomb, may we continue to share that love in ways both big and small, trusting that God will use it to bring hope and healing to the world.


