



Opening Prayer

<u>Secretary's Report/</u>Approval of prior Minutes: Motion to approve January Minutes by Laurie, Seconded by Bryan. Motion approved.

<u>Ireasurer's Report</u>/Approval of Report: Motion to approve Report by Laurie, Seconded by Michele. Motion approved. Dylan only had reports up to January as he's behind due to tax season. A CD at the credit union matured this month so we rolled it into a new one.

Pastor's Report:

- Shepherd of the Prairie Lutheran Parishes-will be closing soon. The last services will be April 27th for Walcott (Pastor will attend this one) and May 18th for Hickson. We'll be sending out postcards to their member list to welcome them to try out KLC. We'll send out another postcard to the community as a whole after the closings as well.
- Pastor Kim Adams-will fill in next Sunday (3/23) in Pastor's absence.
- Kindred Kids committee- has 3 new people who are considering filling the positions.
- Missions Committee- have added 2 new people to their group.
- VBS-postcards are in the works for the May 27-29 event.
- Confirmation-students participated in a hunger experience and have a packet to work on at home during Lent while classes are not in session. They are also encouraged to attend the Wednesday evening Lenten services.
- Easter Brunch- the Fellowship committee is wondering if Confirmation students/family would want to provide the brunch as a fundraiser for future events.
- First Communion class- will be held Sunday April 13th.
- Weddings-there are 3 weddings on the schedule (7/19 in Superior, 9/5 at KLC, and 10/17 in Casselton) and we'll need Pastoral support on 7/20.
- Funeral-there's one planned in June over the Synod Assembly weekend.
- Synod Assembly-we've added another person to attend the meetings that weekend.
- Baccalaureate-is planned for May 4th at 7pm, this will coincide with Senior Night.

<u>Updates from Directors:</u>

Faith Formation & Growth:

- Kindred Kids-will be having an easter egg hunt on Palm Sunday. The end of the year program will be on 5/4 with the kids singing and helping during worship, and will ask the Fellowship committee about having a potluck that day.
- VBS-committee and anyone having input will meet 3/17 to plan the event. It will run May 27-29th (Tue-Thur) with more details and sign ups for volunteering to come.

Management & Grounds:

- Natural Gas- we received a quote for the change over at the church and parsonage.

 (\$4500 for a new furnace/change over at the parsonage and \$2400 for the 4 furnaces at church to be changed over)
- Heating the church-blowers in the church furnaces were serviced recently and now the heat is being distributed much better.
- Painting at church-Sharlene Mattson painted the old nursery/bathroom area in the basement, and is touching up other areas in the sanctuary.
- New nursery- a new room is set up in the basement on the east side of the Sunday School wing. There's also a TV in there for parents to watch the services.

Social Ministry & Outreach

- Fellowship Committee- will try to do potlucks once/month.
- Volunteers- have been added to a few committees.
- Easter Brunch- planning has started and will have more details soon.

Old Business:

- Youth Director-no new applicants, but will keep trying.
- Directory- no news to report.
- Improvements Committee- Brandon Kub is interested in being a part of this group.

New Business:

- Council Installation Date-Sunday, April 6th during worship.
- Shrimp boil- Rodney Braaten is leading this event on Sunday, April 27th.
- Projector for worship- a new one is needed and we're looking at options to replace it.
- Maintenance Company- a company the school uses recently came to the church to share how they could help us with supplying paper products (paper towels, toilet paper, etc. at wholesale prices), maintaining equipment (deep clean the dishwasher twice a year, service vacuums, etc) and provide soap/chemicals. We'll get quotes and see if this is something that would be beneficial to us.
- Shepherd of the Prairie-(Walcott/Hickson church)-Pastor Kyle and Leah recently went there to look at items at their churches. They would like to give items to other churches that would be of use. They're also entrusting us with their church's archives.
