Call to Order-meeting called to order at 6:38 by Rich Schock. Rich, Gene, Lisa, Lori, Susie, Lloyd and Kathryn present.

Additions / Approval of Agenda

Secretary's Report/Approval of Minutes-Motion to approve Secretary's report by Lori. Second by Gene. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's Report / Approval of Report-budget was close to \$16,000 ahead for 2021. Will need to adjust some budget items (especially technology) for 2022. Some of the funds were cleaned up. LOC continues to be around \$19,000. Auditing looking at budget from 2021. April 1st payroll will be moved to the new accounting firm. Rename Youth and Children's fund to Kindred Kids Committee for budget moving forward. VBS would like to possibly increase budget for next year but pending to see if funds need to be split between KLC and Norman. Budget for 2022 will be similar. Proposed staff budget increase for next year discussed. Susie made a motion to increase Bekki's salary by \$1.00. Second by Kathryn. Motion approved to increase Bekki's report by Lori. Second by Lisa. Treasurer's report approved.

Updates from Directors

Faith Formation & Growth:

- No Sunday school on February 20th.
- Trish will be inviting youth group for Lenten dinners. Youth group meeting on Wednesday nights. Will meet with Conformation group 15 minutes prior, discuss and then attend church together.
- Lori requesting increasing funds for VBS.
- Wait to meet on Director/Committee members until after Lori's replacement can be included.

<u> Management & Grounds:</u>

- Bid from Dakota Hills Electric. Fixtures in kitchen and fellowship hall bid was \$3400.
- Bid pending from Kody's Electric.
- Gene has lock for parsonage garage but it has not yet been put on. Also has a seal to put on washing machine.

Social Ministry & Outreach:

- Fellowship project completed! Carpet will be cleaned once the lights are changed out.
- Donor for approximately half of 120 chairs (\$5000)-Susie will talk to Ham's dinner about receiving funds to possibly cover some of the rest.

Old Business

- Call committee update-Call committee recommended Kyle Giermann. Tentative start date will be April 1st, 2022. Need to give 2 week notice to discuss at annual meeting. Would vote for 2022 budget, the call of Pastor Kyle and need to vote on Pastoral salary (both vote of Pr. and Pr's compensation package will be written votes). Council accepts call committee's recommendation and will bring the recommendation forward to the congregation at the annual meeting.
- Church app-will likely get rid of. Will also get rid of Vanco which is the electronic giving. Will look at possible options that we can combine both. Table until next meeting.
- Ash Wednesday-Installation of Council members on Wednesday March 2nd-Bekki will work with Pr. Ernie and work with him on planning service. Will contact Pr. Ernie to see if he would like to continue with Sunday's on March.
- Lent Supper- Vicki Thompson organizing-confirmation students meeting just before services. Reminderno pulpit supply needed for services will be doing "radio show" and Holden Evening prayer service.
- Annual meeting Decision made for no Zoom for Annual meeting, because the electronic voting requirements are difficult to keep track of. Have communion on February 27th to make sure membership requirements are fulfilled prior to meeting. Susie will make sure that Leah is aware of the addition and keep other communion dates the same.

New Business

- Budget Proposal 2022-see treasurer's report.
- Fellowship time change-will go back to after service after Annual meeting.
