A lot of exciting things are happening this February! On February 12 we have our Annual Meeting, where everybody gets to have a say in the life of KLC. Also on February 12, we are excited to bring back Contemporary Worship, led by Eldon Johnson. On February 26, we will be welcoming Red Willow Ministries for Camp Sunday during our regular worship time. This is a great opportunity to get to know one of the ministries we support and how our children and youth can have an opportunity to grow their faith in an exciting environment. Along with Camp Sunday, we will also be having a potluck to bring us all together on February 26. Among all this excitement, we will enter into the season of Lent.

Lent might be my favorite season out of the church year. Lent, which this year begins on February 22, is the 40 days, plus 6 Sundays, that lead up to Easter. This is a time of conversion that focuses on prayer, fasting and almsgiving. During these 40 days, we are urged to reflect on our lives, perform acts of charity, and make small sacrifices. Each pillar prepares us for the joyful celebration of Christ's resurrection on Easter Sunday.

During Lent, we traditionally try to give something up, whether that is something we really enjoy or a bad habit we have. While this can be very powerful, this year I want to encourage you to try something a little different. Instead of giving something up, consider taking something up. Instead of trying to quit something cold turkey, try making a new habit, whether that is doing something that is good for you or something that will benefit many. And if trying something new isn't in your wheelhouse, I encourage you to consider how you can give of yourself this Lent. Volunteer to serve in the community. Give to those who are in need. Spend time with those on the outside. Whatever you choose to do this Lent, do it with purpose and do it knowing that God is with you and guides you through these 40 days.

Finally, I want to invite you to join me on a journey during Lent. I am excited to be leading a Bible & Book study on The Lord's Prayer and I hope you will be able to join. We will meet on Tuesdays at either Noon or 6:30pm (you choose when you want to come). Each week we will focus on a different part of the Lord's Prayer and how it acts in our daily lives. The study on Tuesdays will be a deeper dive into the topics for our Wednesday night Lenten Services.

I hope that you are able to take part in some or all of these exciting things this February.




